

Unfiltered Privacy Policy

Golden Voice Technologies, Inc. (“Unfiltered,” “we,” “our,” and/or “us”) values the privacy of individuals who use our mobile application, websites, and related services (collectively, our “Services”). This privacy policy (the “Privacy Policy”) explains how we collect, use, and share information from users of our Services (“Users”). By using our Services, you agree to the collection, use, disclosure, and procedures this Privacy Policy describes. Beyond the Privacy Policy, your use of our Services is also subject to our Terms of Service (<https://www.unfiltered.photo/tos>).

Information We Collect

We may collect a variety of information from or about you or your devices from various sources, as described below.

A. Information You Provide to Us.

Registration and Profile Information. When you sign up for an account, register to use our Services, sign up for notifications or updates, or participate in our surveys, we ask you for your first and last name, username, phone number, and a profile photo.

Communications. If you contact us directly, we may receive additional information about you. For example, when you contact us for customer support, we will receive your name, email address, phone number, the contents of a message or attachments that you may send to us, and other information you choose to provide.

B. Information We Collect When You Use Our Services.

Location Information. When you use our Services, we may infer your general location information, for example by using your internet protocol (IP) address.

Device Information. We receive information about the device and software you use to access our Services, including IP address, web browser type, operating system version, phone carrier and manufacturer, application installations, device identifiers, mobile advertising identifiers, and push notification tokens.

Your Camera Roll. In order to use our Services, we request access to the camera roll on your device so that we may present you with throwback photos to share with your friends who also use our Services. If you choose to share a throwback photo with a friend, and that friend agrees to share or “swap” their throwback photo with you, we download and store the photo from your camera roll and facilitate the sharing of that photo with your friend on our Services.

Usage Information. We automatically receive information about your interactions with our Services, like the content you upload or share (including photos) and the dates and times of

your visits.

Your Contacts. In order to use our Services, we request access to the address book on your device so that we may access and store names and contact information from your address book to facilitate your connection to existing friends and to new friends when they join our Services.

Information from Cookies and Similar Technologies. We and our third-party partners collect information using cookies, pixel tags, or similar technologies. Our third-party partners, such as analytics and advertising partners, may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across different services. Cookies are small text files containing a string of alphanumeric characters. We may use both session cookies and persistent cookies. A session cookie disappears after you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains after you close your browser and may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to our Services.

Please review your web browser's "Help" file to learn the proper way to modify your cookie settings. Please note that if you delete or choose not to accept cookies from the Service, you may not be able to utilize the features of the Service to their fullest potential.

C. Information We Receive from Third Parties.

Other Users. We may receive additional information about you, such as your contact information, from other Users' address books.

How We Use the Information We Collect

We use the information we collect:

- To provide, maintain, improve, and enhance our Services;
- To personalize your experience on our Services such as by providing tailored content and recommendations;
- To understand and analyze how you use our Services and develop new products, services, features, and functionality;
- To communicate with you, provide you with updates and other information relating to our Services, provide information that you request, respond to comments and questions, and otherwise provide customer support;
- For marketing and advertising purposes, such as developing and providing promotional and advertising materials that may be relevant, valuable or otherwise of interest to you;
- To send you text messages and push notifications;
- To find and prevent fraud, and respond to trust and safety issues that may arise;
- For compliance purposes, including enforcing our Terms of Service or other legal rights, or as may be required by applicable laws and regulations or requested by any judicial process or governmental agency; and
- For other purposes for which we provide specific notice at the time the information is

collected.

How We Share the Information We Collect

Affiliates. We may share any information we receive with our current and future affiliates for any of the purposes described in this Privacy Policy.

Vendors and Service Providers. We may share any information we receive with vendors and service providers retained in connection with the provision of our Services.

Sharing Between Users. Our Services are a social service in which you can share daily “throwback” camera roll photos with mutual friends (meaning you each have the other’s information in your mobile address book). Users with whom you are mutual friends will be able to see your Unfiltered profile, which includes your first name, username, profile photo, friends, and the number of messages you have exchanged. We are not responsible for the other Users’ use of available information, so you should carefully consider the content you post to your profile and which photos you elect to send as direct messages through the Services.

Marketing. We do not rent, sell, or share information about you with nonaffiliated companies for their direct marketing purposes, unless we have your permission.

Analytics Partners. We use analytics services such as Google Analytics to collect and process certain analytics data. These services may also collect information about your use of other websites, apps, and online resources. You can learn more about Google’s practices by visiting <https://www.google.com/policies/privacy/partners/>. To help us understand how you use our Services and to help us improve them, we automatically receive information about your interactions with our Services, like the pages or other content you view, the searches you conduct, people you follow, any content you post, and the dates and times of your visits.

Advertising Partners. We work with third-party advertising partners to show you ads that we think may interest you. Some of our advertising partners are members of the Network Advertising Initiative (<https://optout.networkadvertising.org>) or the Digital Advertising Alliance (<https://optout.aboutads.info>). If you do not wish to receive personalized ads, please visit their opt-out pages to learn about how you may opt out of receiving web-based personalized ads from member companies. You can access any settings offered by your mobile operating system to limit ad tracking, or you can install the AppChoices mobile app to learn more about how you may opt out of personalized ads in mobile apps.

As Required By Law and Similar Disclosures. We may access, preserve, and disclose your information if we believe doing so is required or appropriate to: (a) comply with law enforcement requests and legal process, such as a court order or subpoena; (b) respond to your requests; or (c) protect your, our, or others’ rights, property, or safety. For the avoidance of doubt, the disclosure of your information may occur if you post any objectionable content on or through the Services.

Merger, Sale, or Other Asset Transfers. We may transfer your information to service providers, advisors, potential transactional partners, or other third parties in connection with the consideration, negotiation, or completion of a corporate transaction in which we are acquired by or merged with another company or we sell, liquidate, or transfer all or a portion of our assets. The use of your information following any of these events will be governed by the provisions of this Privacy Policy in effect at the time the applicable information was collected.

Consent. We may also disclose your information with your permission.

Your Choices

Sharing Preferences. Your throwback photos are not shared with your friends unless both you and the mutual friend agree to swap photos. The photo sharing is ephemeral, meaning they will disappear from your shared feed after 24 hours.

Friend Blocking. We provide you with privacy settings to allow you to block friends from viewing your profile information or contacting you via the Unfiltered app. Blocking someone will mutually “unfriend” or remove both users from each other’s friends list. A blocked user will not be notified that they have been blocked.

Camera Roll and Contacts Information. You can prevent your device from sharing the camera roll or contacts with us at any time through your device’s operating system settings. **If you choose not to provide us with camera roll and contact information, some features of our Services may not work as intended.**

Marketing Communications. You can unsubscribe from our promotional emails via the link provided in the emails. Even if you opt out of receiving promotional messages from us, you will continue to receive administrative messages from us.

Third Parties

Our Services may contain links to other websites, products, or services that we do not own or operate. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of these third parties. Please be aware that this Privacy Policy does not apply to your activities on these third-party services or any information you disclose to these third parties. We encourage you to read their privacy policies before providing any information to them.

Security

We make reasonable efforts to protect your information by using physical and electronic safeguards designed to improve the security of the information we maintain. However, as no electronic transmission or storage of information can be entirely secure, we can make no guarantees as to the security or privacy of your information.

Children’s Privacy

We do not knowingly collect, maintain, or use personal information from children under 13 years of age, and no part of our Services is directed to children. If you learn that a child has provided us with personal information in violation of this Privacy Policy, then you may alert us at privacy@unfiltered.photo.

International Visitors

Our Services are hosted in the United States and intended for visitors located within the United States. If you choose to use the Services from the European Union or other regions of the world with laws governing data collection and use that may differ from U.S. law, then please note that you are transferring your personal information outside of those regions to the United States for storage and processing. Also, we may transfer your data from the U.S. to other countries or regions in connection with storage and processing of data, fulfilling your requests, and operating the Services. By providing any information, including personal information, on or to the Services, you consent to such transfer, storage, and processing.

Update Your Information

You can update your account and profile information or delete your account through your profile's account settings. To delete your account, navigate to "account settings" on your profile, click "request deletion" and then "confirm deletion".
